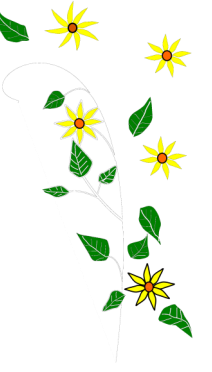
January we had one family member to visit from Pinetops, NC. Kairos spent Saturday the 21st getting ready for Kairos #32 scheduled in March.
